

Can you help us develop a new treatment for OCD?

Study Details

Monarch Mental Health Group (MMHG) in partnership with Australian National University (ANU) is looking for volunteers to participate in a clinical trial to investigate how effective Transcranial Alternating Current Stimulation (tACS) is in treating obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD).

You may be eligible to take part if you:

- Are aged between 18 - 65 years
- Have a diagnosis of OCD.

What's involved in the trial?

- You will apply tACS using a portable battery-operated device. Treatments and assessments will be performed at your own home.
- Your tACS treatments will be personalised based on a baseline EEG recording (conducted at the research centre in Surrey Hills. You will receive reimbursement for your travel costs.
- Medication therapy is permitted to continue during the trial.
